

# Storyboard for “How to Movie”

## *ADV. MULTIMEDIA ASSIGNMENT*

**The planning stage is key to the success of any video project. These stages include the *story*, the overall visual look of the project, and the actors.**

### *Requirements:*

1. A storyboard is kind of like a cartoon version of your film; it also serves as an overall outline for your film. See the last page of Digital Video Packet for the Storyboard handout.
  - minimum of 20 panels.
2. Under each panel identify the action and type of shot:
  - downward, upward, eye level, two shot, over the shoulder, wide shot, medium shot, close up, extreme close up
3. The actually video needs to be a minimum of two minutes.
