Course Title: Advanced Multimedia

Length: One year • Ten Visual Art credits

Course Description: In this course students will master the skills and knowledge necessary to produce art, illustrations, and brochures directly from a Macintosh computer using Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and Indesign. Students will learn animation using Adobe LiveMotion and Adobe Flash. The history of animation will be introduced. Students will master web design using Adobe GoLive. Students will learn video editing using iMovie and Adobe Premiere. Each student will use a scanner, a digital camera, and a video camera. The “Core” of the curriculum has been adapted from Adobe’s Classroom in a Book Series.

Course Objectives:

The student will:

- A. produce works of art through creative expression,
- B. develop an understanding of artistic perception,
- C. demonstrate technical knowledge,
- D. explore careers in the various fields of graphic design / multimedia.

Homework Policy: Homework will be assigned periodically. Students who do not complete assignments in class will need to plan time to complete assignments at lunch, after school, or during “S” period.

Absence / Make-Up Policy: Students are expected to make up work within five school days of their last absence. For extenuating circumstances, please consult with the instructor.

Grading Policy: Each student’s grade will be composed of points earned by completing lessons, assignments, tests, and projects. The majority of the class work will be project based.
