Course Title: Multimedia

Length: One year • Ten Visual Art credits

Course Description: In this course students will develop the skills and knowledge necessary to produce art and illustrations directly from a Macintosh computer using Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign. Students will learn animation and web design using Adobe Livemotion and GoLive. Students will learn video editing using iMovie. Each student will learn to scan pictures and use a digital camera. The “Core” of the curriculum has been adapted from Adobe’s Classroom in a Book Series.

Course Objectives:

The student will:

- A. produce works of art through creative expression,
- B. develop an understanding of artistic perception,
- C. demonstrate technical knowledge,
- D. explore careers in the various fields of graphic design / multimedia.

Homework Policy: Homework will be assigned periodically. Students who do not complete assignments in class will need to plan time to complete assignments at lunch, after school, or during “S” period.

Absence / Make-Up Policy: Students are expected to make up work within five school days of their last absence. For extenuating circumstances, please consult with the instructor.

Grading Policy: Each student’s grade will be composed of points earned by completing lessons, assignments, tests, and projects. Also, students will be tested on the Adobe standards for each application. Points will be deducted for late assignments and projects.
